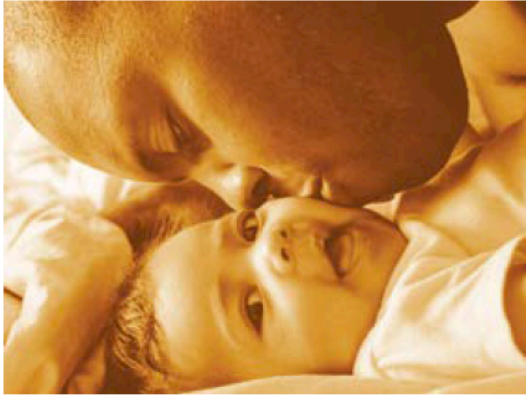

## *How to Build a Culture of Life*

### THE PROBLEM .....

*Watching the news and reading the headlines, we may feel helpless seeing the heartbreaking lack of respect for human life. How do we respond when our efforts seem small in the face of the culture of death?*

### OUR CHRISTIAN IDENTITY .....

To understand more fully how to defend and protect human life, we must first consider who we are, at the deepest level. God creates us in his image and likeness, which means we are made to be in loving relationship with him. The essence of our identity and worth, the source of our dignity, is that we are loved by God: "We are not the sum of our weaknesses and failures; we are the sum of the Father's love for us and our real capacity to become the image of his Son."<sup>1</sup>

We are called to divine intimacy, true communion with God, and we can grow in this closeness with him through daily prayer, reading the Scriptures, and frequent participation in the sacraments, especially Confession and the Eucharist.

### OUR MISSION AS CHRISTIANS .....

The knowledge and realization of how deeply we are loved by God elicits a response of love that simultaneously draws us closer to God and, at the same time, impels us to share his love with others.

Embracing a relationship with God means following in his footsteps, wherever he may call. Just as Jesus invited St. Peter and St. Andrew to become his disciples, he invites us to do the same: "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men" (Matthew 4:19).

Being a disciple of Jesus naturally includes sharing the Gospel with others and inviting them into a deeper relationship with God. As Christians, our identity and our mission are two sides of the same coin; like the apostles, we are called to be missionary disciples.

### MISSIONARY DISCIPLESHIP .....

This doesn't necessarily mean quitting our jobs or moving to foreign countries. For most of us, our mission field is daily life: "Christ teaches us how to evangelize, how to invite people into communion with him, and how to create a culture of witness: namely, through love. A Christian life lived with charity and faith is the most effective form of evangelization."<sup>2</sup>

The first step towards living this life is allowing Jesus to meet and transform us daily. If we respond to his grace, our lives will show we have something beyond what the world offers: we follow a person whose love changes our lives, so we want others to also experience his transforming love.

When we live in union with God, open to his prompting, we're more able to see the opportunities for witness and his guidance in responding to these opportunities. We may fear doing the wrong thing or saying the wrong thing, but we do not need to be afraid. Jesus promised his disciples, "I am with you always, until the end of the age" (Matthew 28:20).

### IDENTITY CRISIS .....

As a society and as individuals, we often measure ourselves by false standards: by what and how much we do, our successes or failures, how others treat us, the degree of our pleasure or independence, etc. And when these changeable substitutes prove to be insufficient, or when we are faced with challenges and suffering, we may feel helpless, alone, or abandoned; we may be tempted to feel as though our lives have decreased value or worth.

But God's love—individual, real, unchanging—is the true source of our worth, identity, and dignity. It really is not a question of who we are, but rather *whose* we are. Because his love will never change, nothing can reduce our God-given dignity, and nothing can diminish the immeasurable worth of our lives.

**OUR RESPONSE** .....

When someone is facing great trials, we need to meet them where they are, walk with them on their journey, intercede for them, and be open to sharing Christ's love however he directs.

When a woman becomes pregnant, and her boyfriend threatens to leave if she continues the pregnancy, we need to lovingly walk with her. When family members or friends become seriously ill, we need to assure them that God still offers them something in this life, and they still have purpose. We need to consistently be with them every step of the way.

Sometimes our actions speak for themselves; other times, words are needed. Whatever the situation, Jesus knows

how to speak to each person's heart; we simply need to follow where he leads.

**A CULTURE OF LIFE** .....

This is how we answer our missionary call. This is how we build a culture of life, a culture that joyfully proclaims the truth of God's love, purpose, and plan for each person. Changing the culture is a process of conversion that begins in our own hearts and includes a willingness to be instructed and a desire to be close to Jesus—the source of joy and love.

When we encounter Christ, experience his love, and deepen our relationship with him, we become more aware of our own worth and that of others. His love for each person is cause for great joy, and growing understanding of this priceless treasure motivates us to share his love with others. Our lives are often changed by the witness of others; so too, others' lives may be changed by our witness and authentic friendship with them.

Let us go, therefore, and not be afraid. God is always with us.

## SERMON ON MARK 10:17-30

One can have all the blessings the world can offer yet feel empty inside. Tom Brady is the most successful quarterback in football history. He won seven Super Bowl rings and earned accomplishments too many to name. He is the GOAT (Greatest Of All Time). Brady made a surprising revelation when interviewed on the "60 Minutes" news show in 2005 after he won his third Super Bowl. Here is a transcript of what he said:

"There are times where I'm not the person that I want to be. Why do I have three Super Bowl rings, and still think there's something greater out there for me? I mean, maybe a lot of people would say, 'Hey man, this is what is.' I reached my goal, my dream, my life. I think: 'it's gotta be more than this.' I mean this can't be what it's all cracked up to be. I mean I've done it. I'm 27. And what else is there for me?"

The interviewer asked, "What's the answer?"

Brady responded, "I wish I knew. I wish I knew."

Both Brady and the Young Rich Man were very similar. They had everything the world could offer. Wealth, security, comfort, pleasure They wanted for nothing. But there lingered this hunger from the soul. There's "gotta be more than this."

Jesus loved this young man who followed the commandments of how God wanted him to love others. Now Jesus showed him how to love God by living the First Commandment. "You shall have no other gods before me."

Jesus explains if you want eternal life, you must rid yourself of the false gods in your life. The rich young man's possessions possessed him. Wealth became his god. Jesus tells him to remove this false idol. Go. Sell. Give. Come. Follow. Make God your only possession. Salvation is not found in worldly wealth but in Heavenly treasure.

I met some interesting people during my two years as a Franciscan friar. Brother James shared his story of how he came to the Franciscans. Like Tom Brady, he had it all. Success in business, lots of money, 15,000 square foot home, and a vintage car collection. (He owned a 1951 orange Pontiac Chieftan which was the car that brought me home as a newborn.) He never married because he could not find a woman who loved him but only his wallet. I remember him saying, "I felt lonely and bored. There are only so many countries to visit, so many fine places to eat and only so many parties to go to. After a while, the thrill is gone." He met a Franciscan priest who owned nothing but was the happiest person he ever knew. He said, "I wanted that." James gave away all his worldly goods. He entered religious life with only a suitcase. "I traded in my Armani clothes and Gucci shoes for sandals and a brown robe. As "Brother" James I have found peace."

Jesus challenges you to dump your false gods. What are the idols that become more important than God? Is there anything that takes the place of God in your life? We all have them but may not recognize them. Even something good may become an idol. If I always take care of others, but don't take care of myself, can become destructive. God does not want this.

Here are four questions to help you identify idols in your life:

- 1) Where do I spend my time?
- 2) Where do I spend my money?
- 3) Where do I get my joy?
- 4) What do I think about the most?

Tom Brady asked, "What else is there for me?" Jesus gives the answer: "But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be." (Matthew 6:20-21) Blessings to you.
